The 12th Annual Bloomin' Beerfest is a unique event held each year, at the Irish Cultural Center and McClelland Library, to celebrate Irish author **James Joyce** with live music, beer-tastings, and readings from his masterpiece, *Ulysses*.

The name "Bloomsday" derives from Leopold Bloom, the novel's protagonist. Bloomsday is celebrated in Dublin and throughout the world by fans of Joyce – beer lovers and literature scholars alike. 2018 marks the 114th anniversary of the events immortalized in *Ulysses*.

Our Bloomsday Celebration includes dramatic readings from *Ulysses* and presentations on Joyce's work, life, and times.



The readings will be performed in the ICC Cottage by the ICC *Ulysses* Readers: Lynn Mascarelli, Jim Daughtery, Coleen Van Slyke, Rich Van Slyke, Vicki Champion, Justin O'Brien and Chas Moore.
