



Frequently Asked Questions

Where is the Camp located?

The Irish Arts Summer Camp (IASC's) will be held at the Irish Cultural Center and McClelland Library at 1106 N. Central Ave., Phoenix, AZ, 85004.

Do participants have to be Irish to attend the Camps?

No, the IASC's are open to all children. This is an excellent opportunity to introduce Irish culture to your children.

Will participants of the IASC's receive any merchandise from the camp?

Yes, participants will receive a complimentary backpack on the first day of their chosen camp. If your child/children attend/s more than one week of camp, please note they will only receive one backpack.

Do you offer pre and post camp care for participants?

Yes, we will be offering pre and post camp care for any participants that need it. From 7.45AM to 9AM and 3PM to 7PM. There will be a charge of \$10 for every hour your child is in pre or post camp care.

Do participants bring their own lunch?

Yes, we ask participants to bring their own packed lunch. Small snacks and water will be provided during the camp. We ask you that you clearly label any personal items your child will bring into the camp with their name. Please keep in mind we are a **nut and peanut free** facility.

What should my child wear to camp?

The program is very creative and active. Closed toe shoes are required. No flip flops! Comfortable clothing so your child can move and get creative.

Will participants be outside during the day?

Majority of the activities will take place indoors. Weather permitting teachers and volunteers may opt to have breaks outdoors under shade. For the Sports Camp there is more of a possibility of participants being outdoors if weather permits.

What is the drop off and pick up procedure?

The Irish Cultural Center's parking lot is located directly behind (west) the Center's buildings. All students need to be signed in and checked out at the end of the day by a parent/guardian or authorized person. ID's will be checked.
