



Frequently Asked Questions

Where is the camp located?

The ICLF Summer Camp Program is held at the Irish Cultural Center and McClelland Library at 1106 N. Central Ave., Phoenix, AZ, 85004.

Do participants have to be Irish to attend the camp?

No, the program is open to all children. This is an excellent opportunity to introduce Irish culture to your children.

Will participants of the camp receive any merchandise from the camp?

Yes, participants will receive some complimentary merchandise on the first day of their chosen camp. If your child/children attend/s more than one week of camp, please note they will only receive one piece of merchandise.

Do you offer pre and post camp care for participants?

No, we do not offer pre and post camp care. Parents/Guardians are required to drop off and pick up at the set times.

Do participants bring their own lunch?

Yes, we ask participants to bring their own packed lunch. Small snacks and water will be provided during the camp. We ask that you clearly label any personal items your child will bring into the camp with their name, we are not responsible for any lost or stolen items.

What should my child wear to camp?

The program is very creative and active. Closed toe shoes are required. No flip flops, unless stated for a specific day or activity! Comfortable clothing so your child can move and get creative.

Will participants be outside during the day?

Majority of the activities will take place indoors. Weather permitting teachers and volunteers may opt to have breaks outdoors under shade.

What is the drop off and pick up procedure?

The Irish Cultural Center's parking lot is located directly behind (west) the Center's buildings. All attendees must be signed in and checked out at the end of the day by a parent/guardian or authorized person.
